Thank you for your unwavering support and trust. We look forward to continuing this journey of learning and growth together.

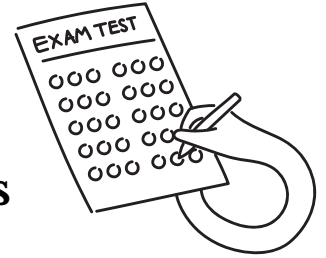

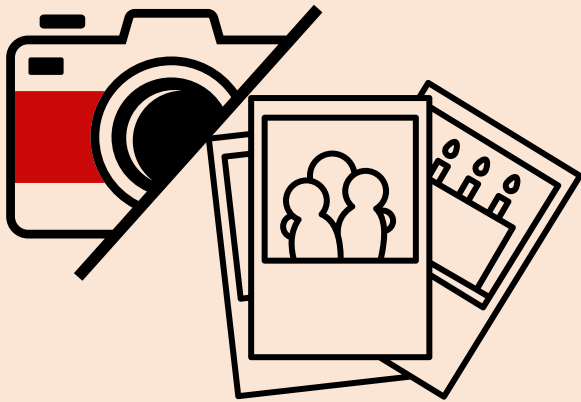
